### CONCLUSIONS and commentary at March 2011

The high mix Industry sectors for Sonning Common in comparison with wider areas were :-

Education at 14.3% (England 9.9%)

Professional, Scientific and Technical at 10.5% (England 6.7%)

Information and Communication at 10.2% (England 4.1%)

Construction 8.9% (England 7.7%)

The lower mix Industry sectors for Sonning Common in comparison with wider areas were :-

Wholesale, Retail and Motor trade at 13.8% (England 15.9%)

Human Health and Social Work at 9.7% (England 12.4%)

Manufacturing 5.8% (England 8.8%)

Transport & Storage at 2.1% (England 5.0%)

Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing at 0.4% (England 0.8%)
