 Sonning Common has a low mix of 1-2 bedroom stock in comparison with SODC and even more with wider areas  
 Sonning Common has a high mix of 4+ bedroom stock, more than SODC and even more than wider areas  
 Sonning Common has a high ave number of bedrooms at 3.1 per average household
