CONCLUSIONS

At March 2011, Sonning Common had a modest 1.7% rate of households without employment and with dependent children - lower than elsewhere.
However it had a large mix of retired people and had a large 34.6% rate of households without employment but without dependent children - significantly higher than elsewhere.
The mix of households with dependent children was similar to those elsewhere.
The mix of households with dependent children aged 0-4 was slightly less than elsewhere. Though this may well equalise by 2031.
The mix of households including one person with a long-term health problem or disability and dependent children was 3.3% and slightly less than elsewhere.
The mix of households including one person with a long-term health problem or disability, but without dependent children, was 20.5% and slightly more than elsewhere.
