## CONCLUSIONS

At March 2011, Sonning Common had a lower mix of one-person households than elsewhere

(Less 18-34 yr olds and lack of appropriate housing stock)

Sonning Common had a rather higher mix of "all 65+" one-person households than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a rather higher mix of family households than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a rather higher mix of family households without dependent children than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a similar mix of households with dependent children as elsewhere.
