### CONCLUSIONS

At March 2011, Sonning Common had a higher mix (15.3%) of one-person (aged 65+) households than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a lower mix (8.7%) of one-person households (aged less than 65) than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a higher mix (16.4%) of family households (all aged 65+) than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a lower mix (15.6%) of family households with couples but no children (Married, CP and Co-habiting) than elsewhere

Sonning Common had a similar mix of households with dependent children as elsewhere.
