## CONCLUSIONS

Lone parents represented 4.8% of households in Sonning Common (in line with SODC (4.6%) and less than SE England (6.1%) and England (7.1%).

(See Household composition (KS))

Unemployment amongst lone parents was lower in Sonning Common (25.7%) than elsewhere (England 40.5%).

Within employment, part-time is greater (at 47.3% of lone parents) and particularly for females.

For male lone parents full-time employment was the greater focus with 100% of male lone parent employment in SC and around 80% elsewhere.
