CONCLUSIONS

There is a slightly high ratio of females in Sonning Common - possibly related to the older demogrphic mix at 2011.

Abbeycrest was not fully operational at March 2011 and the % of people in communal living shows slightly lower than elsewhere.

(There are of course no children's homes or boarding schools in SC)

Sonning Common only became a parish in 1952 and has a lot of population in a small parish area. The density thus appears very high.
